## **ALWAYS** place in your bin:

- ✓ Cardboard always flattened (including CLEAN pizza boxes)
- ✓ All clean paper AND wrapping paper (no metallic paper – place in trash)
- ✓ Plastic bottles, jugs, jars and tubs
- ✓ Cans, bottles and cartons <u>always</u> CLEAN, DRY AND EMPTY

NEVER BAG RECYCLING!

## **NEVER** place in your bin:

- Electronics \*
- Stvrofoam \*
- Plastic Bags, Film, and Plastic Shipping Envelopes \*
- Cooking Oil \*
- Pharmaceutical Bottles \*
- Batteries \*
- Food
- Single Use Plastics plates, cups, utensils, napkins
- Bows, ribbons, wire, twine, decorations

Still unsure? Follow this rule: WHEN IN DOUBT, THROW IT OUT!
